An Act exempting the position of police chief in the town of Barnstable from the civil service law.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the position of
2 police chief in the city known as the town of Barnstable shall be exempt from chapter 31 of the
3 general laws.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall not impair the civil service status of any incumbent holding
5 the position of police chief in the city known as the town of Barnstable on the effective date of
6 this act.

7 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
