An Act relative to the town of Sterling.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the town of
2 Sterling is hereby authorized to revoke its acceptance of 108L of chapter 41 of the General Laws.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
