(2015-2016)**

An Act designating a portion of Route 3 as the Middlesex 3 highway.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The section of state highway route 3 from the Burlington and Arlington town line to the
- 2 Chelmsford and Westford town line shall be designated and known as the Middlesex 3 Highway,
- 3 in honor of the Middlesex 3 Coalition for their commitment to improving economic activity
- 4 along the corridor. The Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain
- 5 suitable markers bearing the designation in compliance with the standards of the department.
