An Act relative to certain municipal employees of the towns of Richmond and West Stockbridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 268A of the General Laws or any  
2 other general or special law to the contrary, a municipal employee of the town of Richmond or  
3 the town of West Stockbridge shall not be prohibited from receiving or requesting compensation  
4 from, or from acting as an agent or attorney for, the town of Richmond or the town of West  
5 Stockbridge, provided that the employee is acting within the scope of the employee’s official  
6 duties pursuant to an intermunicipal agreement entered into pursuant to section 4A of chapter 40  
7 of the General Laws.

8           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
