## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act authorizing the town of Clinton to grant additional liquor licenses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the
- 2 licensing authority of the town of Clinton may grant up to six (6) additional licenses for the sale
- 3 of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises under section 12 of said chapter 138. The
- 4 licenses shall be subject to all of said chapter 138 except said section 17.
- 5 (b) If any license granted pursuant to this section is cancelled, revoked or no longer in
- 6 use, it shall be returned physically, with all of the legal rights, privileges and restrictions
- 7 pertaining thereto, to the licensing authority and the licensing authority may then grant the
- 8 license to a new applicant under the same conditions as specified in this act.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
