**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to insurance discounts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special laws to the contrary, motor vehicle
2 insurance companies shall have the option of offering insurance discounts to licensed operators
3 of motor vehicles who complete a marijuana impairment education course. The course may be
4 offered by accredited driving schools and insurance companies, pending approval from the
5 commissioner of insurance, and the course curriculum must include a module on the dangers of
6 driving under the influence of marijuana.
