An Act to protect the collective bargaining rights of certain administrative employees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1 of chapter 150E of the general laws is hereby amended by inserting after the  
2 second sentence of the definition of “employee” the following sentence: No person employed by  
3 the commonwealth in the so-called management series, below the level of M-VI, shall be  
4 excluded from the coverage of this chapter unless either the department of labor relations has  
5 determined that the actual duties of the particular position or positions meet the test of a  
6 managerial employee established in the second sentence of this paragraph or an agreement exists  
7 with the exclusive representative of the bargaining unit that covers similar types of work.
