An Act recognizing film production in Massachusetts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Subsection (1) of section 6 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:
- 3 (9) A motion picture shall include a credit and a logo, approved by the commissioner in
- 4 consultation with the Massachusetts film office, stating that the motion picture was filmed in
- 5 Massachusetts and displaying a logo designed and approved by the Massachusetts film office.
- 6 The credit shall include the following title: "Proudly Made in Massachusetts".
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 38X of chapter 63 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 8 adding the following subsection:

- 9 (h) A motion picture shall include a credit and a logo, approved by the commissioner in
- 10 consultation with the Massachusetts film office, stating that the motion picture was filmed in
- 11 Massachusetts and displaying a logo designed and approved by the Massachusetts film office.
- 12 The credit shall include the following title: "Proudly Made in Massachusetts".
