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An Act to ensure electric motor vehicle charging fairness.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1            Subsection (d) of section 16 of chapter 25A of the General Laws, as appearing in the  
2            2020 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:- The owner or  
3            operator of a public electric vehicle charging station shall assess the cost for electric vehicle  
4            charging services on a per-kilowatt-hour basis and may assess further charges for electric  
5            vehicles that remain connected to the charging station after being fully charged.
