In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act regarding the appointment of officials and employees of the town of Andover.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter 571 of the Acts of 1956 (The Andover Town Charter) as subsequently
- 2 amended, is hereby amended as follows:
- First, by deleting the entirety of Section 3(d) and replacing it with the following:
- 4 "The town manager shall appoint, subject to the approval of the select board, upon merit
- 5 and fitness alone, and may, subject to the provisions of chapter 31 of the General Laws where
- 6 applicable, remove for cause the positions of Deputy Town Manager, Police Chief, Fire Chief,
- 7 Finance Director/Chief Financial Officer, Town Clerk and Town Counsel, a board of public
- 8 health, a planning board, a board of assessors, a board of library trustees, and all other officers,
- 9 boards, committees of the town, with the exception of the elected officials specified in section
- two, and employees of such elected officials."
- 11 Section 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
