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**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court  
(2023-2024)**  
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An Act further regulating the retirement rights of certain employees of Plymouth County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 2A of chapter 124 of the acts of 1953, as inserted by chapter 260 of the acts of  
2   1987, is hereby amended by inserting after the words "assistant criminal identification officer  
3   employed by the county of Barnstable" the following words:- or the county of Plymouth.
