**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act establishing Building Trades Recovery Week.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 15IIIII the
2 following section:-

3 Section 15JJJJJ. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the last
4 week in April as Building Trades Recovery Week, for the Buildings Trades Employers
5 Association to promote awareness of the dangers of opioids and substance misuse among
6 workers in the construction industry and facilitate discussions and events to combat the opioid
7 epidemic and promote mental health in the commonwealth's building construction industry.
