**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act authorizing the city of New Bedford to grant a utility easement to the University of Massachusetts Dartmouth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The City of New Bedford may grant an easement to the University of
2 Massachusetts Dartmouth for the purpose of installing and maintaining underground utilities
3 under a portion of the land owned by the City at Fort Taber Park. The portion of the land over
4 which an easement may be granted and under which utilities are installed is shown on the Utility
5 as Built Plan entitled, “UMASS DARTMOUTH SMAST ii, 760 S. RODNEY FRENCH BLVD
6 DARTMOUTH, MA,” prepared for Bond Brothers by Brennan Consulting and dated
7 03/09/2018.

8 SECTION 2. As a condition of granting the easement and allowing the installation and
9 maintenance of underground utilities authorized by section 1 the University of Massachusetts
10 Dartmouth shall restore the surface above the installed utilities, including all paths and other park
11 infrastructure altered by the installation, and the land shall continue to be used for park purposes

12 under Chapter 45 of the Massachusetts General Laws and Article 97 of the Amendments to the
13 Constitution of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

14 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
