By Mr. Cyr, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 2435) of Julian Cyr, Kip A. Diggs and Steven George Xiarhos (by vote of the town) for legislation to authorize the city known as the town of Barnstable to change the use of a portion of land within Mother’s Park. **In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act authorizing the city known as the town of Barnstable to change the use of a portion of land within Mother’s Park.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, and in
2 accordance with M.G.L. c. 3, § 5A, the town council of the city known as the town of Barnstable
3 may change the purpose of 5,803 square feet of land within Mother’s Park as shown on a plan of
4 land titled “Approval Not Required Plan Mother’s Park 20 Phinney’s Lane” drawn by Town of
5 Barnstable Department of Public Works dated 2/23/2023 for the purpose of making public safety
6 improvements by reconfiguring the intersection of Phinney’s Lane and North Main Street as
7 shown on said plan. The town of Barnstable may make minor modifications to the plan to carry
8 out this act.

9 SECTION 2. As consideration for the change of purpose of the land described in section
10 1, the town of Barnstable shall dedicate for park purposes land of not less than 9,288 square feet

11 within the discontinued portion of Mother's Park Road to increase the area of Mother's Park as
12 shown on the plan referred to in Section 1.

13 SECTION 3. The town manager of the town of Barnstable may execute and record on
14 behalf of the town any instruments necessary to carry out this act.

15 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
