**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act further regulating the authority of the town manager in the town of Duxbury to negotiate and execute certain contracts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 3, C, 13, of the Acts Providing for a Town Manager in the Town of
2 Duxbury, shall be amended to read, "The town manager shall be responsible for the negotiation
3 and execution of all contracts (with the exception of union collective bargaining agreements and
4 individual employment contracts), subject to such authorization as may otherwise be required
5 under applicable law by the Town Meeting, Board of Selectmen, or other board or commission
6 of the town. The Town Manager shall be responsible for the negotiation of union collective
7 bargaining agreements under M.G.L. Chapter 150E, and individual employment contracts. The
8 board of Selectmen is responsible for the ratification of these agreements and contracts, and for
9 the execution of these agreement contracts."

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
