**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to the composition of the Salem Board of Health.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 654 of the acts of 1972 is hereby repealed.

2 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 26 of Chapter 111 of the General
3 Laws, the Board of Health of the City of Salem shall consist of five members, at least one of
4 whom shall be a physician.

5 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
