**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court  
(2015-2016)**

An Act making a corrective change for a certain reserve fund in the town of Hingham.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 479 of the acts of 2014 is hereby amended by striking out the first paragraph and  
2 inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:-

3 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the town of Hingham school  
4 committee may establish a reserve fund to be utilized in any fiscal year or years by the town of  
5 Hingham school committee to pay, without further appropriation, for unanticipated, unbudgeted  
6 or extraordinary costs of special education out-of-district tuitions and transportation. The town  
7 of Hingham school committee may appropriate or transfer, in any fiscal year or years, from the  
8 school department budget in order to fund said reserve fund.
