An Act exempting certain positions in the city of Marlborough from the Civil Service Law.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the positions of  
2 sergeant, lieutenant and captain in the Marlborough Police Department, and all clerical,  
3 custodial, and technical positions in the City of Marlborough shall be exempt from the provisions  
4 of chapter 31 of the General Laws.

5           SECTION 2. This act shall not impair the civil service status of a person holding a  
6 position described in section 1 on the effective date of this act.

7           SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
