An Act changing the membership of the old and historic district commission of the town of Marblehead and lengthening the commission's determination period for a certificate of appropriateness.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Amend Chapter 101 of the Acts of 1965, An Act Establishing the Old and
- 2 Historic Districts Commission of the Town of Marblehead as follows:
- a. by omitting the second part of the second sentence in Section 4. Which now reads;
- 4 "Each member shall be a resident of the town of Marblehead and shall reside in an historic
- 5 district established under this act."
- To read instead; "Each member shall be a resident of the town of Marblehead and shall
- 7 reside in the historic district established under this act except the Board of Selectmen may
- 8 appoint no more than one member from outside of an historic district."
- b. by changing the second word in Section 8 which now reads: "Within ten days...."
- To read instead; "Within twenty-one (21) days..."

- SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
- SECTION 3. The General Court may reasonably vary the form and substance of the
- requested legislation within the scope of the general public objectives of this petition.
