An Act exempting the position of deputy chief of police in the town of Winthrop from the civil service law.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1: The position of Deputy of Police of the Town of Winthrop shall be exempt  
2 from Chapter 31 of the General Laws.

3           Section 2: This act shall take effect upon its passage.
