**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court  
(2015-2016)**

An Act designating a certain boat launch area in the town of Pelham as the William E. Pula fishing area.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The boat launch area 1, located at Gate 8 in the town of Pelham, shall be  
2   designated and known as the William E. Pula Fishing Area. The department of conservation and  
3   recreation shall erect and maintain a suitable marker bearing that designation in compliance with  
4   the standards of said department.
