**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to the charter of the town of Eastham.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter C9-5N of the charter of the town of Eastham, which is on file in
2 the office of the archivist of the commonwealth as provided in section 12 of chapter 43B of the
3 General Laws, is hereby amended by changing in the last sentence the word “three” to “five”, so
4 that the sentence reads:- “The Capital Projects committee shall consist of (5) voting members
5 and other nonvoting members, as follows”;

6 SECTION 2. Chapter C9-5N is further amended by adding in subsection (1) the words
7 “and two at-large members”, so that the subsection reads: (1) A Selectmen and two at-large
8 members, to be appointed by the Board of Selectmen (voting members).

9 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
