In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act designating May as Asian American Pacific Islander month.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1.	Chapter 6 of the	ne General	Laws is hereb	y amended by	y inserting after	section

2 15BBBBBB by the following new section:-

- 3 Section 15CCCCCC. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the
- 4 month of May as Asian American Pacific Islander Month, in recognition of the significant
- 5 contributions Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders have made to the Commonwealth and to the
- 6 United States and recommending that said month be observed in an appropriate manner by the
- 7 people. After consultation with Asian American and Pacific Islander groups, the governor may
- 8 include in the proclamation such contributions as he shall see fit.
