In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to a senior exemption for the town of Harwich.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of clause Forty-first C of section 5 of
- 2 chapter 59 of the General Laws, or of any other general or special law to the contrary, the Board
- 3 of Assessors in the Town of Harwich is hereby authorized to grant an exemption to the amount
- 4 of \$1,500 of assessed taxable valuation to individuals meeting the qualifications contained in
- 5 clause Forty-first C of section 5 of chapter 59.
- 6 SECTION 2. In the fiscal year in which this act takes effect, the Town of Harwich is
- 7 hereby authorized to reimburse those eligible for a senior exemption under clause Forty-first C of
- 8 section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws to the amount of \$500.00.
- 9 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
