An Act relative to placing a plaque at the McCarthy Pavilion in the city of Revere in memory of Grace Hill Sannella.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           A plaque shall be installed at the northeast side corner of the McCarthy Pavilion located  
2 in the Revere Beach reservation which is under the care and control of the department of  
3 conservation and recreation in the city of Revere in memory of Grace Hill Sannella for her 42  
4 years of faithful service to the citizens of the city as an advocate for Revere Beach. The  
5 department of conservation and recreation shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing the  
6 designation in compliance with the standards of the department which shall include the  
7 inscriptions:

8           “Her time is forever, everywhere is her place”, and

9           “November 22, 1939 – June 3, 2018”.
