An Act designating a section of state highway route 10 and United States highway route 202 in the town of Southwick as the Purple Heart Trail.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the section of state highway  
2 route 10 and United States highway route 202 located in the town of Southwick shall be  
3 designated and known as the Purple Heart Trail, in honor of the brave recipients of the Purple  
4 Heart. The Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain suitable  
5 markers bearing that designation in compliance with the standards of the department.
