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**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act authorizing certain investments by the Treasurer of the town of East Bridgewater.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding general or special law to the contrary, the Treasurer of the
2 town of East Bridgewater is hereby authorized to invest any funds of the town in the custody of
3 the Treasurer in accordance with Sections 3, 4, 5, 8, and 9 of Chapter 203C of the general Laws
4 in accordance with the town of East Bridgewater's Cash and Investment Policy, as the same may
5 be amended by the town of East Bridgewater, acting by and through the Board of Selectmen,
6 from time to time.

7 SECTION 2. Section 54 of Chapter 44 of the General Laws shall not apply to the town of
8 East Bridgewater.

9 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.
