An Act relative to wastewater treatment and disposal in the town of Provincetown.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Provincetown is hereby authorized to extend its sewer system
2 to allow for new connections and expanded treatment capacity and to make assessments on
3 properties benefited by such expansion pursuant to chapters 80 and 83 of the General Laws.

4 SECTION 2. The town may make equitable adjustments to the annual charges
5 established pursuant to section 16 of said chapter 83 for the use of common sewers by owners of
6 land who connect to the town’s sewer system for the purpose of ensuring an equitable
7 distribution of the total sewer system costs, including assessments and sewer use charges.

8 SECTION 3. Chapter 157 of the acts of 2000 is hereby repealed.

9 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon passage.
