An Act establishing the Massachusetts Law Enforcement Memorial Fund.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 10 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after section 35PPP the following section:

3 Section 35QQQ. There shall be established and set up on the books of the commonwealth  
4 a separate fund to be known as the Massachusetts Law Enforcement Memorial Fund to be used  
5 without appropriation by a department of public safety for the purpose of making annual  
6 payments to the Massachusetts Law Enforcement Memorial to memorialize and honor  
7 Massachusetts law enforcement personnel killed in the line of duty. There shall be credited to the  
8 fund revenues received by the commonwealth from the sale of registration plates under section  
9 2G of chapter 90.
