By Representative Robertson of Tewksbury, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3964) of David Allen Robertson (by vote of the town) for legislation to exempt Joanne Ricardelli from the maximum age requirement for appointment as a firefighter in the town of Wilmington. **In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act exempting Joanne Ricardelli from the maximum age requirements for firefighters in the town of Wilmington.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding chapter 31 of the General Laws or any other general or
2 special law regulating the maximum age of applicants for appointment as firefighter to the
3 contrary, Joanne Ricardelli, a resident of the town of Wilmington, shall be eligible to have her
4 name certified for original appointment to the position of firefighter in the town of Wilmington,
5 notwithstanding her having exceeded the maximum age before taking the civil service
6 examination in connection with that appointment. Joanne Ricardelli shall be eligible for
7 appointment to the position of firefighter in the town of Wilmington if she meets all other
8 requirements for certification and appointment to this position. This section shall apply to the
9 2022 and 2023 civil service firefighter examinations.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
