An Act exempting the position of deputy fire chief of the town of Chelmsford from the civil service law.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. The position of deputy fire chief in the town of Chelmsford shall be exempt  
2 from chapter 31 of the General Laws.

3           Section 2. Section 1 shall not impair the civil service status of any person holding the  
4 position of deputy fire chief in the town on the effective date of this act.

5           Section 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
