**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to collective bargaining dues.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 10 of chapter 150E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after subsection (a)(6), the following
3 subsection:-

4 “ (7) Refuse to provide payroll deduction for membership dues as authorized by
5 employees represented by the Exclusive Representative.”
