**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to clarifying legislative intent regarding the non-competition law.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (iii) of subsection (c) of section 24L of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in section 21 of chapter 228 of the acts of 2018, is hereby amended by adding, after
3 the words “terminated without cause”, the following:- “as defined by the parties in the
4 noncompete agreement”.
