**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to postpartum depression screening.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 118E of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 10N the
2 following section:-

3 Section 10O. The division shall provide coverage of screenings by pediatricians for
4 postpartum depression in parents of newly born children during any visit to a pediatrician’s
5 office taking place for up to 1 year from the date of the child’s birth.
