An Act relative to the curatorship program.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 44 of chapter 85 of the acts of 1994 is hereby amended by inserting  
2 at the end thereof the following sentence:-

3           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, any historic property  
4 designated as such by this section shall not be subject to the provisions of chapter 59 of the  
5 General Laws.
