In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act to reduce lottery littering.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Massachusetts State Treasurers Office shall instruct the Massachusetts

2 State Lottery to develop a second chance game involving all lottery tickets and scratch tickets

3 that do not contain winning numbers. The purpose of the game shall be to increase the amount of

4 scratch tickets and lottery tickets recycled and reduce the amount of scratch tickets and lottery

5 tickets thrown away or littered.

- 6 SECTION 2. The second chance game must be operational no later than 180 days of the
- 7 passage of this bill.
