## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to veteran health care.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 115, Section 5 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by adding after paragraph 7, the following:-
- 3 "The Secretary of Veterans' Services shall promulgate regulations ensuring that should
- 4 any applicant or recipient be determined as under 300% of the current Federal Poverty Level
- 5 (FPL) and is otherwise qualified, the applicant or recipient shall be eligible for a Medical Only
- 6 budget."
