An Act relative to electric ratepayer protections.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Chapter 164 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 1K the
2	following section:-

3	Section 1L. Beginning on January 1, 2025, no supplier, energy marketer or energy broker
4	shall execute a new contract for generation services with any individual residential retail
5	customer. This section shall not apply to, or otherwise affect, any government body that
6	aggregates the load of residential retail customers as part of a municipal load aggregation
7	program pursuant to section 134. Any violation of this section shall be deemed an unfair and
8	deceptive act pursuant to chapter 93A. The attorney general may bring an action under section 4
9	of said chapter 93A to enforce this section and to obtain restitution, civil penalties, injunctive
10	relief or any other relief available under said chapter 93A.
