PROVISION OF ALTERNATIVE WATER

- ▶ Intended for MassDEP defined Sensitive Sub-Group
- ▶ Contracted with Vendor to provide bottled water
- ▶ Wednesdays & Sundays - Punch Card System – 1400 Households
- ▶ \$22,000 weekly for water distribution at Transfer Station
- ▶ Nursing Home/Assisted Living/Day Care - \$14,000 monthly
- ▶ Rebate Program – Currently 625 Households - \$20,000 monthly
- ▶ Considering Water Vending Stations - \$5,000 per unit monthly
- ▶ Staff Engagement – Customer Relations
