## Adjusted rates with new \$45K TWB

- Rates were adjusted to show (1) nominal level and (2) to equal a collection equal to 1% of total covered payroll
- These rates in Example 1 range from 0.36% to 5.49% and collect roughly the same amount of revenue as was collected in 2019
  - This equals a 62% tax rate reduction on a Taxable Wage Base of \$45,000
- To capture more revenue, Example 2 shows a range of rates from 0.42% to 6.47% with roughly \$2.0B in revenue

• This equals a 55% rate reduction on a Taxable Wage Base of \$45,000

• These rates would be lower than any allowed under even Schedule A

## Adjusted rates with new \$55K TWB

- Rates were adjusted to show (1) nominal level and (2) to equal a collection equal to 1% of total covered payroll
- These rates in Example 1 range from 0.29% to 4.48% and collect roughly the same amount of revenue as was collected in 2019
  - This equals a 69% tax rate reduction on a Taxable Wage Base of \$55,000
- To capture more revenue, Example 2 shows a range of rates from 0.36% to 5.49% with roughly \$2.0B in revenue
  - This equals a 62% rate reduction on a Taxable Wage Base of \$55,000
- These rates would be lower than any allowed under even Schedule A
