**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to timely retirement payment.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (B) of subdivision (1) of Section 13 of Chapter 32 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following after
3 the words “allowance becomes effective.”, the following:

4 “In the event circumstances beyond the retirement board’s control prevent the calculation
5 of the full monthly payment by the first such full payment date, the retirement board shall pay
6 90% of its estimated full monthly payment until such time as the circumstances beyond the
7 retirement board’s control are corrected. On an annual basis, the retirement board will notify the
8 House and the Senate of all circumstances beyond the retirement board’s control that prevented
9 the calculation of the full monthly payment by the first such full payment date.”
