## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to wildlife rehabilitators.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 58 of Chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after subsection 9 the following:
- 3 10. The giving of aid or care of sick, injured, debilitated and orphaned wildlife by a
- 4 trained wildlife rehabilitator, as permitted by the Division of Fisheries and Wildlife in
- 5 accordance with 321 CMR 2.13. Permitted wildlife rehabilitators shall enter into a signed
- 6 written agreement with a veterinarian subject to written approval by the Division of Fisheries and
- Wildlife which shall outline the specific procedures, services, responsibilities, and limitations of
- 8 the wildlife rehabilitator.
