Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 209A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking subsection (h) and inserting in place thereof the
- 3 following subsection:-
- 4 (h) ordering the defendant to refrain from abusing or contacting the plaintiff's child, or
- 5 child in plaintiff's care or custody, unless authorized by the court, which shall survive the death
- 6 of the plaintiff until such order expires or is vacated by the court;.
