An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Stephen Przybycien, an employee of the Executive Office of Health and Human Services .

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the executive office of health and human services, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law, or rule, or regulation to the contrary, the  
2 executive office of health and human services shall establish a sick leave bank for Stephen  
3 Przybycien, an employee of the office. Any employee of the office may voluntarily contribute 1  
4 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Stephen Przybycien.  
5 Whenever Stephen Przybycien terminates employment with the office or requests to dissolve the  
6 sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended  
7 illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or  
8 disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the office of  
9 health and human services.
