**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to gun safe tax deductions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of Part B of section 3 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 62 of chapter 68 of the acts of 2014, is hereby further amended by
3 adding the following subparagraph:-

4 (17) The amount equal to the amount of a purchase of a gun safe; provided however, that
5 such deduction shall not exceed \$2,000 for a single person, for a married person filing a separate
6 return of a head of household, or a married couple filing a joint return.
