**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to motor vehicle registration plates.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2014
2 official edition is hereby amended in lines 151 and 152, by striking the words “two number
3 plates of suitable design” and inserting the words “one number plate of suitable design to be
4 placed at the rear of the vehicle”,

5 SECTION 2. Section 6 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws as so appearing is hereby
6 amended in lines 6 and 7, by striking the following words: “at the front and one”.
