An Act relative to spouses as caregivers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 9 of Chapter 118E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding in the second sentence of the second paragraph,  
3 after the words “requirements for Title XIX” the following new language:--

4           “; provided further that any program of home and community based services funded  
5 pursuant to the provisions of this chapter or pursuant to the provisions of chapter one hundred  
6 and eighteen G, in which family members are permitted to serve as paid caregivers, shall include  
7 spouses within the definition of family member; provided further the Executive Office of Health  
8 and Human Services shall file a state plan amendment or wavier application, as is required to  
9 allow spouses to serve as paid caregivers.”
