The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to spouses as caregivers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 9 of Chapter 118E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding in the second sentence of the second paragraph,
- 3 after the words "requirements for Title XIX" the following new language:--
- 4 "; provided further that any program of home and community based services funded
- 5 pursuant to the provisions of this chapter or pursuant to the provisions of chapter one hundred
- 6 and eighteen G, in which family members are permitted to serve as paid caregivers, shall include
- 7 spouses within the definition of family member; provided further the Executive Office of Health
- 8 and Human Services shall file a state plan amendment or wavier application, as is required to
- 9 allow spouses to serve as paid caregivers."
