An Act relative to disability insurance benefits.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 108F. No insurance policy or plan, insuring persons disabled by  
2 reason of injury, illness or disease shall discriminate against any insured person by eliminating  
3 benefits or by reducing benefits by reason of the insured person being disabled, either in whole  
4 or in part, by a mental or nervous condition; or by “self-reported,” symptom or symptoms which  
5 have been documented by a duly licensed physician.
