An Act relative to prevention of EBT fraud.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 SECTION 1. Section 27A of chapter 18 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the word "designate." and inserting in place

- 3 thereof the following:- "designate; provided that, every sixth check must be collected at the
- 4 recipient's local branch office. The recipient shall be required to present a photo identification to

5 receive said check."
